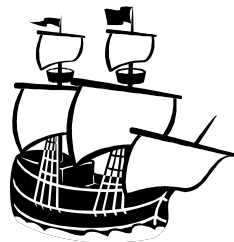

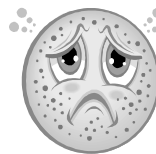

COUNTIES MANUKAU POLICE are leading an awareness campaign in the run-up to Halloween on 31 October to help keep young people safe and minimize unwanted trick or treaters for householders.



Senior Sergeant, Mike Fulcher said: "We want the community to feel safe in the lead up to Halloween. The purpose of this campaign is to educate young people about the do's and don'ts at this time of year; it isn't to spoil young people's fun but to prevent anti social behavior from taking place. Halloween should not be used as a

chance to upset others. "We are urging young people to take care if they decide to go trick or treating. It is important that younger children are accompanied by an adult and that any trick or treating is carried out at a sensible time, preferably while it is still light. Spooktacular things to remember for Halloween include:

- stay in well lit areas
- children should be accompanied by an adults and only houses where you or your friends know the residents
- be visible and stay with your friends
- do not frighten elderly people and respect people who do not want trick or treaters coming to their doors
- do not commit a crime thinking you will get away with it because it is Halloween
- householders do not have to respond to knocks at the door

If there are problems or incidents that you're worried about, contact police for advice or assistance.
