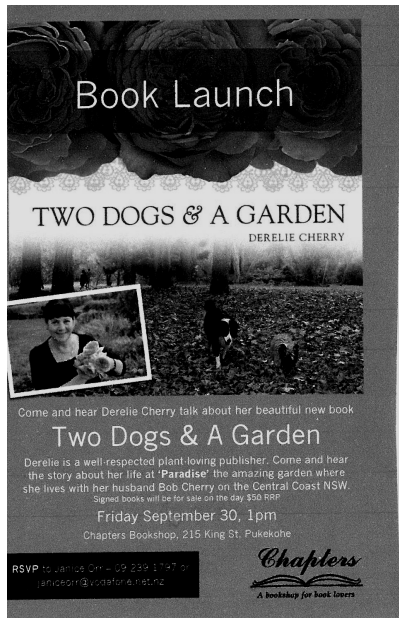

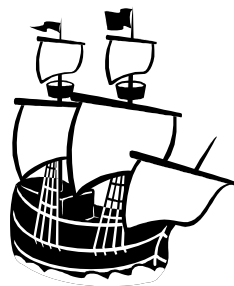

CALF CLUB DAY SATURDAY 8 OCTOBER
