Kids Loop: Approx 1-1.5km long. This is designed for young and novice riders who are not confident on the main loop. Anyone under 16 on this loop must have adult supervision. NO EXCEPTIONS. NO RIDING IN THE PITS.

Anyone who has a 2 or 4 wheel off-road motorcycle that is in good condition can enter. NO CHILDREN UNDER 7 ON THE MAIN LOOP. Children under 16 must be accompanied by a riding adult/parent/guardian.
