

Motocross Day Sun 23rd May 8am – 4pm

This is one of the Mr Motorcycles Fun Days that are run all over Franklin during autumn. Each one is hosted by a different organization usually a school or kindy, and this year we are lucky enough to have one hosted by us! Our venue is a couple of large maize paddocks at Te Kohanga (about 3 km from Tuakau Bridge). Other schools have managed to raise a considerable amount of money at theirs and our school is very excited about this opportunity. Our money will purchase up to date reading comprehension resources.

These events are hugely popular and becoming more and more so as the word spreads, riders come from all over Franklin, Auckland and Waikato. In fact Mr Motorcycles has advised us last week that we need to be prepared for over 400 riders plus families! As this number is huge compared to what we had originally expected we now require much more help and food and, well... everything really.

The areas of help required are manpower, food prep, chilly bins, sign making and home baking.

Manpower – 2 hour time slots in the following areas: cooking on BBQ's, assembling burgers, taking money, selling drinks, mobile drinks vendor, selling baking/lollies/snacks, cooking hot chips, track maintenance/supervision, parking (7.30am – 9.30am), finish flag person (1 hour slots), registration.

Sign making - someone needed to make signs for tents and signs with prices to be ready for Fri 21st May.

Food Prep – this will be done on Fri 21st at 3pm in school kitchen. It involves preparing onions for the BBQ, breaking up lettuce then sealing into bags for burgers, cutting burger buns then re bagging them and bagging up lollies.

Baking – home baked sweet items like muffins, slices, cake & biscuits. Items must be wrapped in plastic wrap in serving size pieces, eg. muffin (not mini ones please), medium sized square of slice, 2 or 3 cookies depending on size, wedge of cake. These will sell for \$1 each so will need to be a reasonable size. Bring to school hall kitchen on Friday 21st May.

Ideally a batch of home baking from each family would be great but realize this may not be possible for some.

Chilly Bins – we need plenty of large chilly bins on the day to store food. Please could you lend yours? Bring to school on Friday 21st May and leave at the school hall kitchen. It must be clearly named.

Thanks to those who have already offered help and baking.
