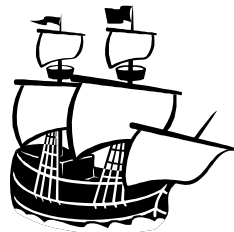

### NEW CLASSROOM

Our next building project commences next week when Running House Removers remove our resource room to allow the construction of a new classroom for the Junior School. This \$240,000 project also includes the construction of a new copier room and relocation and upgrade of our Electrical Supplies. Yellowstone Construction have the contract to build the room and the project should take about 10 weeks to complete. We expect the Removers on **Wednesday 17 June**, after school has started. The site will be fenced off and there will be no access to the Junior & Middle school from the drop off zone until a new concrete path is laid. Students and parents will need to use the path around the back of Room 1. Parents for Room 4 & 5 students will need to collect their children from the netball court side of the classroom.
