SCHOOL ORGANISATION 2010

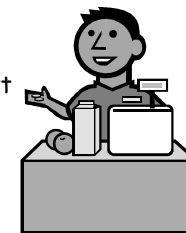
Yes, it's that time of the year already. We need to make an accurate projection of our starting roll in 2010. This will enable us to:
