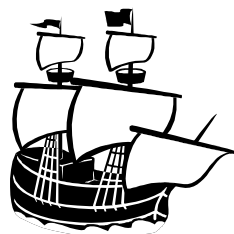

### NATIONAL STANDARDS AND REPORTING TO PARENTS

Parents are aware via the media that it is the government's intention to introduce National Standards for Reading, Writing and Mathematics in 2010. Each standard will clearly state the expected level of achievement of each child compared with others at that age and level across New Zealand. Clear and direct, plain language reporting to parents is expected to show how their children are achieving and what they can do to help.

The Ministry of Education is organising consultation meetings from 25 May- 3 July 2009. They have selected a cross section of schools to consult with so that parents, family and whanau members can share their views. Bombay school was not selected.

I am attending a Principals meeting on June 8, and I have received Draft Standards for reading, writing and mathematics for 4 levels of schooling to share with the staff.

- After one year at school
- By end of year 4
- By end of year 6
- By end of year 8



Much of the content of our current report forms will remain the same, but we will be including statements telling where each child is achieving in relation to the National Standards.

Our triangular interviews with student, teacher and parent at the end of the term will be a starting point to give parents a summary of their child's progress and will also focus on the next steps that are needed, both at school and at home.
