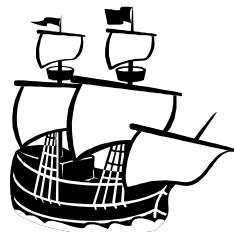

INFLUENZA A (H1N1) SWINE FLU

We have received information from the Ministries of Health and Education. According to them, there are clear signs of the early stages of a pandemic. Schools and early childhood services by their nature are susceptible to many viruses and influenza is readily spread by children.
