

## **BOMBAY NETBALL CLUB PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES**

### **Purpose**

All teams representing Bombay Netball Club are expected to maintain appropriate behaviour standards at all times. These guidelines are to ensure that players are aware of their responsibilities, maintain appropriate behaviour and are aware that consequences may result for inappropriate behaviour.

### **Guidelines**

- Players read, understand and comply with these guidelines.
- Appropriate paperwork and fees are returned to the Team Manager in a timely manner.
- Players are advised to respect and co-operate with team mates, coach, team manager, umpires, officials and opponents.
- Players attend all practices and games, are punctual and ready to start on time.
- Players are dressed appropriately for practices (eg clothing and footwear is appropriate, no swear words on tops, no chewing gum)
- Players do not use inappropriate language and gestures.
- Players are to consult with the Coach and Manager if a game, tournament or practice is to be missed, notification of non-attendance must be given to the team coach or manager only, at least one week prior if possible.
- Players are to accept the team management decisions and umpire's decisions without dissent.
- Smoking, drug use and alcohol consumption is prohibited whilst in the team environment and/or uniform.
- Players are to wear the Bombay Netball Club uniform with pride in a neat and tidy manner. Players are also to maintain their uniform and return it clean and tidy at the end of the season.
- Players who do not follow acceptable behavioural standards are at risk of being warned, stood down or dismissed from the team, depending on the severity of the infringement. A Disciplinary Committee will determine the appropriate outcome.
- Players are encouraged to maintain regular and effective communication with their coach and manager.
- Players are requested to advise the team management of any injuries or illnesses that may affect their performance.
- Players will participate to the best of their ability, have a positive sporting attitude, be a good team member and strive to enjoy the game - win or lose!
- A healthy competitive spirit is the key to participation, success and enjoyment in sport.

If a player has any issue or concerns, these should be raised with the team management in the first instance. If a resolution cannot be agreed, the player should contact the Bombay Club Captain for advice and guidance where necessary.
