Welcome to the 2010 netball season.

Registrations

All girls wishing to play for the Bombay Netball Club must complete the attached Registration Form together with full payment of fees before Tuesday 16 February 2010, to be eligible to trial. First year players please supply a copy of birth certificate. Please be aware that due to resources available, teams may be restricted and existing club members will have priority so registration may not guarantee a placing in a team. Registration dates are 11 & 16 February 2010, 5 - 7pm, Bombay School.
NO LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Fees

Fees have been provisionally set for the 2010 season at:

If there is a fee increase from PNC the fees will be altered. All cheques made payable to Bombay Netball Club. Families with three or more players may apply directly to PNC for a family discount.

Trials

Trials will be held Sunday 21st and Sunday 28th of February 2010 at Bombay School. All intending players must attend both trials and players are trialling against their own position, not all players in the team. Please bring a drink and correct footwear as you will be playing.

Uniforms

Bombay Netball Club will hire you a uniform (dress & jacket) for the season, the cost of which is included in fees. The uniform belongs to the club and must be returned in good condition. There will be a uniform return evening at the end of the season. All players must supply their own correct footwear, plain white short socks and black underwear. G strings and black shorts are not permitted. Long sleeved black thermals are permitted for the juniors to wear under their dress during inclement weather. The PNC games convenor will stop games for incorrect uniforms to be removed. Only correct uniform jackets should be worn at the netball courts. Hair tied back, no earrings or body piercings anywhere on the body, fingernails to be cut.

Game Days

All games are played at Pukekohe Netball Centre. Kiwis play on Friday nights and Juniors, Seniors and Premier teams any time during Saturday. Teams must be at the courts 30 minutes before their game to warm up and complete sign in sheets.

Umpires

Each Kiwi and Junior team must supply their own umpire every week. It is the responsibility of the team to find a mother who is willing and capable of umpiring or the team pays a qualified umpire to umpire each week. Paying an umpire will be an extra cost to parents. The Bombay Netball Club suggests payment of \$5/game for a junior theory umpire; \$10/game for a junior qualified umpire; \$15 for a senior umpire; and \$20/game for a white shirt umpire. Each Senior team (Grade 2 or higher) must supply a list of players umpiring qualifications and umpires will be allocated games by PNC appropriate to their level of umpiring ability.
