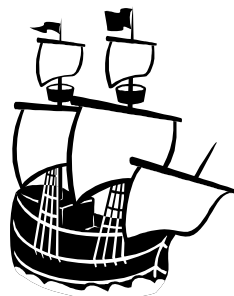

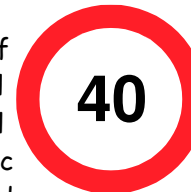

40 KM/HR SCHOOL ZONE

Auckland Council has advised the Board of Trustees that it's request for a 40 km/hr school speed zone sign has been approved as the school meets the criteria set out in the N.Z..A Traffic Notes 37 and 56. Funding has been allocated and a memorandum of understanding signed. Once Auckland Council has a design of the proposed zone they will consult further with the board. The overall process is expected to be completed by the end of Term 4, 2011.



The zone will operate at the following times

- 35 minutes before the start of school until start of school ie. 8.15am - 8.50am
- 20 minutes at the end of school, commencing no earlier than 5 minutes before the end of school ie. 2.50pm - 3.10pm
- For 10 minutes at any time of a day when at least 50 children cross the road.

SCHOOL HOURS

There has been an increase in the number of children being dropped off at school before 8.00am and the number of children still waiting to be collected after 3.15pm. We ask for parents cooperation with this matter please. There is no supervision of children before 8.00am and children must not enter their classroom until their teacher is present. We expect all children to be collected by 3.15pm. The only children at school after 3.15pm are the children waiting for Bus and those children at Kids After School. Teachers have meetings after school and we can not supervise children after 3.15pm.
