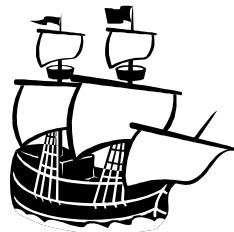

**Room 12, 13** = Brandy Snaps - now.

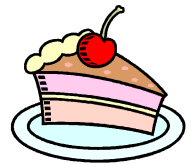
Thank you to everyone - hopefully this will all help to ease the cake-making flurry just before the **BIG DAY**.
