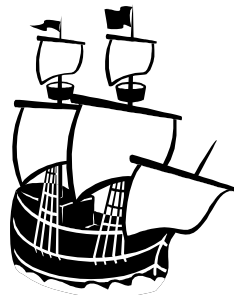

### TRUSTEE RESIGNATION
