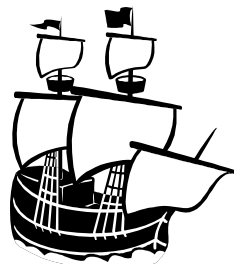

**PGG WRIGHTSON FRANKLIN GROUP DAY-WEDNESDAY 26 OCTOBER**

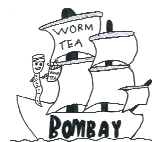
Entries this year are only \$3 per child—last day to enter **8 October**. Your child does not have to have won any ribbons on our day—all children can enter.
