## YEAR CONTEXT

- 1 <u>Exploring the School Grounds</u>: Walks around school grounds and school surrounds. Tree climbing, exploring under Macrocarpa hedge, adventure playground, etc.
- Exploring Bombay: Visit to Mt William, introduce mapping, visits to Bombay Store, Service Centre, dairy farm, poultry farm, nursery etc. Cooking on hobo stove and over open fire sausages, damper, etc.
- 3 Overnight Stay: Classroom or Scout Hall (summer). Cooking on campfire or BBQ. Trips within Franklin i.e. Jane Gifford, Alexandra Redoubt, etc.
- 4 <u>Overnight camping in school grounds</u>: Under canvas cooking on BBQ or Hillbilly Stoves, full hike Mt William.
- 5 & 6 Overnight Camp 2/3 nights in local area: i.e. Farm with suitable facilities, during summer, under canvas in camping ground, use of school camp facility i.e. Port Waikato, Awhitu etc.
  Bi-annual Port Waikato School Camp.
- 7 & 8 Overnight Cabins / Camping: Maximum 4 nights
  Utilising local parents resources, i.e. Whangamata or Pauanui
  Recognised Camp Facility i.e. Port Waikato, Goat Island, Matamata,
  Whangamata, Pauanui.
  Bi-annual Motutapu Island School Camp.
