SAFETY PROCEDURES FOR CONTACTORS AT BOMBAY SCHOOL

- 1. All contractors must report to the school office on arrival.
- 2. Prior to confirming contracts, the contractor will have provided the school with evidence that they have appropriate insurance cover for all liabilities.
- 3. Noise and dust levels must be kept to a minimum during school hours.
- 4. All equipment must be appropriately stored when not in use.
- 5. Machinery and goods must be delivered at appropriate times when students are in classes.
- 6. The project site must be fenced off with 'caution tape' to ensure safety related to holes / drains/ scaffolding etc. unless specifications require a more permanent fence.
- 7. During, and on completion, all debris will be removed and the site returned to its previous state.
- 8. Bombay School is a Smokefree school. Refer to Government Smokefree Legislation.
- 9. Contractors are not permitted to bring their children with them when working on the school site during school holidays.
- 10. Dogs are not permitted on the school site.
