RATIONALE

Self Review is the process by which the school assesses its own performance.

PURPOSE

To promote continuous school improvement by:

- Maintaining an ongoing plan and programme of self review
- Documenting how the National Education Guidelines are being implemented
- Acknowledging what the school is doing well
- Using this information as the basis for future planning and school improvement.

GUIDELINES

- 1. Our school self review will be based on our charter, strategic plan, annual development plan and the National Administrative Guidelines.
- 2. It will also incorporate the evaluation of data on student achievement which will be analysed and strategies for improvement developed.
- 3. Curriculum review will be ongoing, focussing on the effectiveness of the delivery and developing students' knowledge and skills.
- 4. The school performance management system will be reviewed annually, focussing on how teachers' performance and development makes a positive difference to learning outcomes for students.

PROCEDURES

- A template will be established annually to plan the review.
- Action plans will be established to cover all aspects of the review.
- The review process will be ongoing as per the cycle established.
