

POLICY

SMOKEFREE ENVIRONMENT

RATIONALE

Bombay School is a smoke-free school

PURPOSE

- To provide a healthier workplace for employees.
- To set a role model for children.
- To ensure the school is a Totally Smokefree Environment.

GUIDELINES

1. Bombay School is a 'Totally Smokefree School'.
2. Smoking will not be permitted at any time or in any part of the school premises. Prominent notices will be displayed.
3. Smokers will be asked to exercise personal restraint and consideration in regard to when and where smoking occurs, to lessen the risk of passive smoking. Offenders will be asked not to smoke on the school premises.
4. For procedures for complaint, refer to Smoke Environment Act 1991.
5. All buildings will display prominent signs indicating that the school is smokefree.

CONCLUSION

This policy considers the rights of smokers and non-smokers. It asks that the school environment and functions are treated as smokefree, thereby protecting employees and children from tobacco smoke.
