

Tuhono Floral Day Entries for Calf Club 2024

Calf Club is being held on **Saturday 21 of September, Week 9, Term 3.**

On the Friday before this is **"Floral Day"** (20 September).

We make 3x floral entries that are judged after school. All children's work is displayed in classrooms on the Saturday of Calf Club for everyone to see.



The following items **are compulsory** for children to make on Floral Day and will be judged by the specific criteria listed below:

1. **Miniature Garden** (Themed around opposites eg hot/cold, day/night, desert/Arctic)
2. **Recycled Container Vase** suitable to hold roadside flowers (not bought flowers)
3. **Floral Vaseline Saucer** design (Colour, pattern/symmetry)

Miniature Garden

- Put together at school on Floral Day.
- The theme for this year's miniature garden is **"Opposites"**
- Students must bring a roasting dish or similar container brought from home, named on the bottom.
- Assortment of bark, stones, moss, plants and other natural materials to make their garden (all brought from home)
- Students can use small plastic toys/ornaments/made items (2 - 3 only)
- Sand will be provided at school for the base of the roasting dish.



Recycled Container for Floral/Greenery arrangement

- Put together at school on Floral Day.
- Recycled containers must be suitable to display a floral arrangement using roadside flowers eg yogurt pottle, milk bottle, fizzy drink bottle.
- Students are to bring in roadside flowers to create an attractive floral arrangement. Not bought flowers.
- Students need to bring items to decorate their container at school.
- Hot glue guns will be provided at school to help them to do this.



Vaseline Saucer

- Put together at school on Floral Day.
- The students will be given a saucer and vaseline at school.
- Please send your child to school with flowers with petals that can be easily pulled off to place and create a pattern on the saucer. Small leaves can also be used.
- Focus will be colour, pattern and symmetry.



On Friday 20 September (Floral Day) we do need some parents to help with these three activities. Please let your child's teacher know if you are able to help on this day.
