Kakahu Floral Day Entries for Calf Club 2024

Calf Club is being held on Saturday 21 September. On the Friday before this, 20 September, we make floral and craft entries that are judged after school. All children's work is displayed in classrooms on the Saturday for everyone to view and enjoy.

The following items will all be done at school -Miniature Garden Animal constructed from Natural Materials Decorated Milk Bottle Planter

These will be judged by the criteria listed. Entries for Calf Club must be the child's effort made on floral day.

Miniature Garden - Maori Myths & Legends theme

- Bring a named baking tray or tin foil oven dishes (rectangular shape is best).
- Assortment of bark, stones, moss, plants and other natural materials to make a garden scene (all brought from home).
- All sand/dirt needs to be covered. They may make objects to put in their garden at home or bring them. The gardens can only have <u>3</u> store bought items.

Animal constructed from Natural Materials

- Create an animal constructed out of natural materials.
- Assortment of bark, stones, moss, plants and other natural materials to make a garden scene (all brought from home).
- Man made items to be kept to no more than <u>3</u> items.

Decorated Milk Bottle Planter

- Children bring a named 2 or 3l empty milk bottle to school.
- Bottles to be cut at home into the learner's desired shape/concept.
- Bottles will be painted at school the week leading up to Calf Club.
- Children will need to bring to school everything they need to decorate their milk bottle planter boxes on Floral Day.
- If a glue gun is needed and you have one at home, send it along as these are limited on the day.
- Learners may bring potting soil for their containers and something to plant in their milk bottles should they wish.
